

LINCOLN L. BERLAND, MD, FSCBTMR

Dr. Berland attended MIT, then completed his final three undergraduate semesters at the University of Wisconsin, Madison, obtaining a BS in Physics in 1971. He graduated from Washington University Medical School in 1975 and completed his radiology residency and Fellowship at the Medical College of Wisconsin in Milwaukee from 1975-1980. Staying on as a junior faculty member there, he subsequently moved to the University of Alabama at Birmingham to become Chief of Body CT and Ultrasound in 1983, later holding several administrative positions including most recently, Vice-Chair for Quality and Patient Safety. He is now Professor Emeritus.

First elected to Fellowship in the SCBT-MR in 1985, Dr. Berland became President of the Society in 2005 and also served as Medical Executive Director from 2006-2009. Dr. Berland is also a Fellow of the ACR and Fellow Emeritus of the SRU. Dr. Berland was elected to the ACR Board of Chancellors as Chair of the ACR Commission on Body Imaging in 2014, and is currently also a member of the ACR Executive Committee.

Dr. Berland began the ACR Incidental Findings Committee in 2006 and has been the first, senior or co-author of twelve white papers on incidental findings and multiple additional related articles on incidental findings. Through the ACR Assist Committee, he is also helping to develop computerized decision support algorithms for these recommendations.

Dr. Berland has been an author or co-author of about 140 papers on multiple topics in body CT, Ultrasound and quality improvement as has written one book and multiple additional book chapters and reviews. He has presented at over 150 local, regional, national and international medical meetings, including 20 as visiting professor. Dr. Berland has also been an advisor to industry on CT, ultrasound and informatics products.
